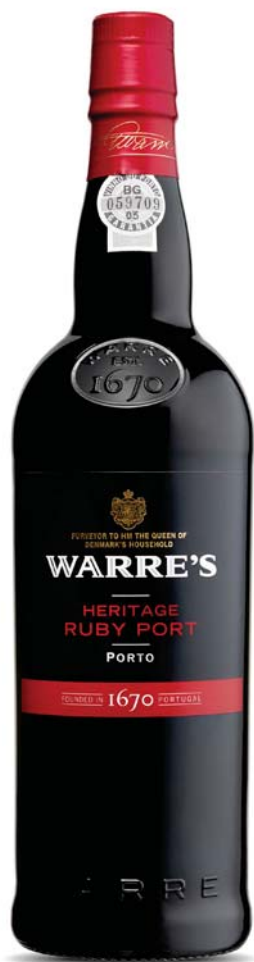


HERITAGE RUBY PORT

THE WINE

Produced in the Douro Valley Portugal, Warre's Heritage Ruby is a robust dark fruity wine full of youthful vigour. Ruby Ports are a blend of young, vibrant wines from different vintages. The wines are stored for up to three years in oak vats before they are blended, filtered and bottled ready to drink. Full and fruity, Ruby Ports have robust, youthful aromas of red fruits and are well balanced and fresh on the palate.
